I know people raised in "Christian" families who attended Catholic, Baptist and even Adventist schools and had bad experiences, which totally turned them off from accepting God and having anything to do with religion. A friend of my wife's since grade school, a woman who grew up going to Catholic schools, said, "If heaven is going to have some of those people there for eternity, I do not want to be there! That would be hell." I had to think about that one.

Is there a case against God? Yes. Are there seemingly unanswered prayers? Yes. Do bad things sometimes happen to good people? Yes. Has religion sometimes distorted the true view of God? Yes. Are all these things evidence that there is no God? No!

Are there enough excuses to be found to justify not believing in God? Yes. Are there enough evidences in this mess of a world to testify that there really is a God? YES! There are no clear answers for many things that happen in life. There are enough things that give the skeptic a reason to be skeptical, a doubter to doubt, and an unbeliever to not believe. Yet if you look with an eye of faith, there are plenty of reasons, yes, evidences, to prove that God does exist and that He is very active in all our lives.

The Bible says: "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1). When we talk about substance, we are talking about something real and tangible when it comes to things we hope for. But more than that, there is adequate evidence, or even signs, to prove that these unseen things are true. Simply put — TANGIBLE PROOF.

## OK —HOW DO YOU EXPLAIN THAT?

One of my best friends is an emergency room doctor. This guy has seen it all — some of the worst things you can imagine. Yet he believes in

God. There are times where someone like him might say, "Why did God let that happen?" Yet God has revealed Himself in many ways, despite the bad things we often see.

My friend's mother was having health problems and it was discovered that she had lymphoma. To be sure the diagnosis was correct, her doctor ordered a CAT scan. Unfortunately, they found lymph node clusters in the diaphragm area of her chest. My doctor friend realized how serious this situation was for his mom.

The local pastor and a couple of elders decided, after hearing about the diagnosis, to have an anointing at his mother's home. They came and prayed with her and anointed her with oil.

Later that week, her physician decided to order a positron emission to-mography scan. These are sometimes referred to as PET scans. These imaging tests help reveal how your tissues and organs are functioning. A radioactive tracer is used to show abnormal activity and is much more comprehensive than x-ray or CAT scan. The doctor was a bit shocked when he found there were no signs of lymphoma at all! The clusters were completely gone!

This is a factual story that happened to close personal friends. I know both the mother and her son (my ER doctor friend), and they both live just a few miles from me. How does an atheist explain such a seemingly impossible reversal?

Yes, there are plenty of hooks to hang your doubts on, but there are also substantial evidences of God working in the midst of all this sin and suffering in the world. As I look back through my life, I see so many times where prayer was answered or a providential meeting took place where the right person was at the right place at the right time.
